# Important Information regarding the BritRail Pass

## BritRail South West Pass – FLEXI 8 Day Pass

The BritRail South West Pass is the best BritRail pass for exploring the gorgeous seaside towns and golden beaches of England's southwest, as well as college towns like Oxford, just north of London.

Travel on day trips to the legendary Stonehenge, Salisbury Cathedral, Windsor Castle, or to King Arthur's Round Table in Winchester. Or enjoy unlimited train travel out to the prettiest towns of Cornwall and Devon, such as Bath, Torquay, St. Ives, and Penzance. You can also explore Wales' principal city of Cardiff and knock another country off your travel bucket list.

This BritRail pass is for unlimited travel on most rail services southwest of London. It includes trains to Oxford, trains to Bath, and trains to Cornwall.

- Unlimited travel from morning until night
- The BritRail South West Pass covers most mainline and branch line carriages operated by First Great Western, South West Trains and Heathrow Express trains
- With a Flexi pass, your travel days do not need to be consecutive – you can travel for a set number of days over a period of 1 calendar month. For example, if you start using a 8 day pass on the 23 March you then have 7 remaining other days that you can use your pass until the 22 April inclusive. Allows you to explore by hopping on and off the trains as you wish (you can make as many journeys as you like in one day)
- Validating the pass: on the first day you clients wish to use the pass, clients must present this, together with an ID (preferably a passport) to any staffed ticket office at a UK train station where it will be stamped. **THE PASS WILL NOT BE VALID UNLESS THIS IS DONE.**
- Available in Standard Class only
- Please advise at the moment of the booking: flight details, all names for all passengers and travel date
- Cancellation Policy: 100% charge 21 days prior to arrival (£ 275.00 per person)

## Important

- guests are travelling with a flexible ticket and will therefore travel at their own leisure; with the flexibility of choosing their preferred train/times
- guests will always need to check train times prior to travel as schedules vary (dependant on month & day of the week) and different routes are available
- guests will always need to check their selected journey as some trains may include a changeover (depending on train/time chosen by client)
- train times will be published up to 3 months in advance

## Questions often asked by guests

Do I need to make seat reservations?

It is not essential to reserve seats on all trains. Generally speaking it is only really necessary to make reservations if you plan to travel on a popular route (e.g. London to Edinburgh) at a peak time (e.g. Friday at 18.00). To make a reservation with a BritRail Pass you need to take your BritRail Pass to the station that you are going to travel from and the travel centre will make the seat reservations for you (for a small fee)

Can I use the BritRail Pass on the tube?

BritRail Passes are not valid on London Transport Underground trains or buses. To travel on the tube you will need either an Oyster Card or a London Travelcard.

Where can I find train timetables?

For information regarding train times, please click on [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk). This is a really useful website for planning trips by train in the UK. All you need to do is type in where you want to go from

and where to, with the date you intend to travel and it will bring up all the details you will need (times, changes if needed, facilities on board etc.).

Which trains are generally included in the BritRail passes?

All train services part of the National Rail network (Virgin Trains West Coast, Virgin trains East Coast, East Midlands Trains, Great Western Railway, Abellio Greater Anglia, Northern Rail, First Trans Pennine Express, Cross Country, Scotrail, Arriva Trains Wales, Chiltern Railways, London Midland, South West Trains, c2c, Abellio Greater Anglia, South West Trains, Great Northern, London Overground, Mersey Rail, Southeastern Trains, Southern, Thameslink)
