Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 Arrival

Arrive in England and pick up your rental car, then make your way to Devon. Today guests will stay in Devon/Barnstaple area.

Day 2 Exmoor National Park

After breakfast you will have the opportunity to explore one of England's beautiful National Parks. Exmoor National Park and its spectacular moorland, rich oak woodland, clear streams and dramatic coastline has a lot to offer. Why not explore the region by joining a tour with Exmoor safaris (not included)? This tour will take you through the beautiful scenery of Exmoor to discover the variety of flora and fauna that it offers; the deer, Exmoor ponies, rare birds, flowering plants and much more! This area is also a haven for food lovers. It is famous for its delicious sea food. For a unique and special experience make sure to book the Seafront Dining Adventure (not included) Take a boat trip with a mackerel fisherman across the Bay of Porlock and see the home of the Porlock Bay oysters. Sample these oysters with a local sparkling wine at Locanda on the Weir, a stunning hotel and restaurant in an idyllic waterfront setting in the 15th Century harbour. Overnight in Devon/Barnstaple area.

Day 3 England's South West Coast: Clovelly village & Tintagle Castle

Today you will depart Devon and continue their journey south to explore Cornwall and its amazing coastline. Make a stop at the beautiful fishing village of Clovelly and stroll along the coastal path or discover the beautiful Clovelly Court Gardens (not included). Immerse yourself in history, myths and stunning scenery at Tintagle Castle (not included), set high on Cornwall's rugged north coast between Padstow and Bude. Inextricably linked with the legend of King Arthur, for centuries this dramatic castle and coastline has fired the imaginations of writers, artists and even the brother of a king. Overnight in Falmouth/St Austell area.

Day 4 South Cornwall Coastline: Penzance - Land's End – St Ives

In the morning guests have the opportunity to explore one of Britain's iconic Landmark Attractions: Land's End. This region is famous for its stunning landscapes & outstanding natural beauty. Drive along the spectacular Penwith Heritage Coast and break for lunch in pretty St Ives. Visit the internationally renowned Tate St Ives and the Barbara Hepworth Museum and Sculpture Garden before making your way back to the hotel. Overnight in Falmouth/St Austell area.

Day 5 Falmouth – Roseland Heritage Coast – St Austell – Lost Gardens of Heligan

In the morning you will have time to drive along England's Roseland Heritage Coast and explore some of the beautiful walking trails. Drive north to visit the Lost Gardens of Heligan (included in package) and explore 200 acres of garden history, mystery and romance. Twenty-five years ago, Heligan's historic gardens were unknown and unseen; lost under a tangle of weeds. It was only the chance discovery of a door in the ruins that led to the restoration of this once great estate. Overnight in Falmouth/St Austell area.

Day 6 Falmouth – Dartmoor National Park – Walks & Trails

After check-out you will make their way north and take a walk through the beautiful Dartmoor National Park. Wild, open moorlands and deep river valleys, with a rich history and rare wildlife, Dartmoor is a unique place. For a unique experience join a guided walk (not included) through a landscape that is rich in history, stories and myths. Listen to your guides experiences of living and working on Dartmoor. This experience will transport you back into a time where pixies, ghosts and witchcraft were part of the daily life on Dartmoor! Learn of the story of the man who fell down a mine shaft and his faithful dog saved his life yet the dog can still be seen within the area. For lunch you will visit a traditional pub, which is said to be haunted. In the afternoon continue your journey and check into your B&B or hotel in Exeter/Torquay area.

Day 7 East Devon area – Red Rocks - Jurassic Coast – Lulworth Cove

Today you will travel along England's South Coast and discover some of the historic Jurassic Coast. The Red Rocks of Sidmouth are famous for its dramatic red rocks viewed both in Ladram or Sidmouth. Take some pictures before continuing your journey. Take in the beautiful scenery of Dorset before stopping at famous Durdle Door and Lulworth Cove. Enjoy an English Pub lunch at the Greyhound Inn (not included) in Corfe and continue your journey towards London. Overnight in London Heathrow Airport.

Day 8 Departure

It is time to fly home. Check out of the hotel and make your way to the airport.
